
a dog's body temperature



signs of heat stroke:

- Heavy panting, difficulty breathing, excessive thirst
- Bright red tongue and mucus membranes, which turn grey as shock sets in
- Thick saliva, drooling, vomiting, and/or diarrhea
- Unsteadiness and staggering
- Lethargy
- By the time the signs of heat stroke are visible, it's often too late.
